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Bernkasteler alte Badstube am Doctorberg Riesling - TBA Dr. Heidemanns-Bergweiler/Bernkastel-Kues - Germany

Terrior The Doctorberg is the prime vineyard of Dr.

Heidemanns-Bergweiler. It is only 4 acres in size and it is held to 100% in the hands of the family. The stony blue-grey clay slate is a residual soil having a very good heat-storing potential, which makes it possible to produce quality grapes for high-end wines. The high proportion of blue slate gives the wine a high content of minerals and finesse. Because of the partly more than

70year old vines the yield is very low.

Description Trockenbeerenauslese - meaning "select dry berry

harvest" or "dry berry selection" made from selected overripe shrivelled grapes often affected by noble rot making extremely rich sweet wines. Typical notes are

honey, extremely ripe or cooked fruit.

Suggestion This type of wine is a classic aperitif or digestive. The

only food that can stand against it is cheese. Try it with a

creamy blue cheese like Roquefort or Stilton.

Quality Level Trockenbeerenauslese

Varietal 100 % Riesling
